The new Fratres were presented with Jewels, Membership Cards, By-Laws, Constitutions, Pledge of Fidelity etc.

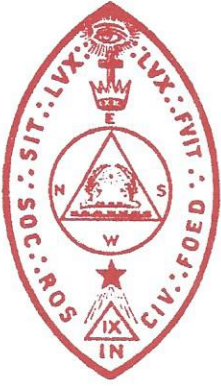
The College was placed at recess and all of the Fratres present congratulated the Neophytes.
