Frater Mower thanked all of the Fratres who assisted in the ritualistic work and complimented them on their outstanding work.

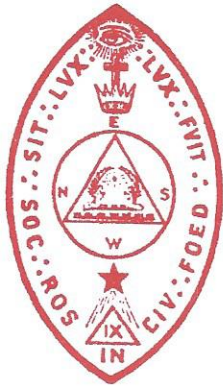
