Minutes of the Semi-annual Convocation, 12/11/10

Chief Adept Mark Irwin opened the meeting in the M***** C***** , and led the fratres in the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag, at 10:05 a.m. at Lombardy Hall, Wilmington, DE.

Officers and members in attendance as per registr.

Minutes of the Annual Communication of 5/25/10 were read and approved, with minor corrections.

The Treasurer's Report indicated a checking account balance of \$475.40, and a renegotiation of the CD to be fifty-four months, at 2.5% interest, interest to be compounded monthly, and reported semi-annually. Amount at the time of renegotiation (8/4/10) was \$2,260.35. Net worth of the College as of this date is \$3,003.61 (plus the unreported interest of August through December.)

Visiting dignitaries, as follow, were introduced and welcomed: James Pletz, Intendant General of the Rose Cross of Constantine, etc., James Herrington as Eminent Prior, Jesse Green Priory #70, KYCH, James Elliott, 33rd degree, Deputy for Delaware of the AASCNMJ, and Harold Littleton and Donald Thomas, both 33rd degree, and active emeriti members of the AASCNMJ, and former Deputies for DE.

Frater James Brittingham was installed as Organist by the Chief Adept.

Fraters Barry Hughes and Robert Benson sent their regrets.

Three fratres have not paid their dues—one of whom's Masonic status is uncertain. PGM Earl Emerson's dues were remitted by proper motion and vote. The third frater has promised to pay when his financial situation permits.

There were no new proposals for membership or requests for demit.

Frater Thomas offered prayer for the departed Past Chief Adept Richard Scarlott, IX degree and Frater Kenneth Spiess, VII degree.

It was reported by Frater Thomas that PGM and Frater Ronald Conaway, who has had bladder cancer, is doing well following the removal of his bladder.

Chief Adept then called the College to be at ease, so the degree team for the seventh degree, Adeptus Exemptus, could take their stations. The cast was as follows:

Inductor Herbert J. Atkinson, Conductor G. Thomas Taylor, Expositor James T. Elliott, and Lecturer Mark E. Irwin.

The degree was then exemplified, with new Frater Neal J. Sobocinski serving as the Candidate.


