A regular meeting of First State College No. 45 was opened in form at 2:55 P.M. with the following officers present:

P.G.G. C. Ray Scarborough presented the Grand Governor for Delaware, Henry G. Law, at the Altar. He was greeted, escorted to the East, and given Grand Honors.

The minutes of the previous meeting (November 6, 1982) were read and approved as read. The Treasurer reported a balance of \$12.32 in the checking account and \$1,395.80 in the savings account.

A motion was made and passed that First State College would meet in the Masonic Temple, Wilmington, Delaware, on November 5, 1983, at a time decided by the Governor and the Excellent Chief of Delaware Council No. 18, K.M.

The Secretary reported that coffee and doughnuts had been provided at the Grand Council-Grand Chapter sessions on March 12, 1983, at a cost of 422.45. Thanks had been received. A motion was made and passed to furnish coffee and doughnuts at the Grand Lodge Communication on October 5, 1983.

A motion was made and passed to donate \$20.00 to the Dover Masonic Hall Corporation.

A resolution to amend the by-laws to conform to the Sovereign College reporting year was presented in proper form to be acted upon at the November meeting.

A letter from Knight of York Vernon Quay expressing his regrets at being absent was read.

The degree of Knight of York was conferred in short form on Companions C. William Tulloch, Harry Donaldson, Mark E. Irwin, and John A. Irwin. Each was presented with a membership card, lapel pin, and white rose by Governor Littel. Grand Governor Law demonstrated the signs.
