P.E. Gov. Irwin expressed appreciation to the cast, especially to last minute substitutes.

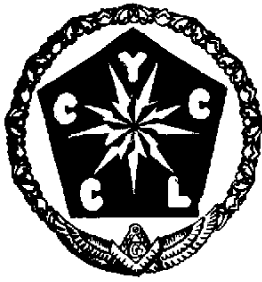
