Dep. Gov. Scarlott announced that James A. Pletz would receive the Purple Cross in Toronto in July. He congratulated P.G. Thomas for a good year.

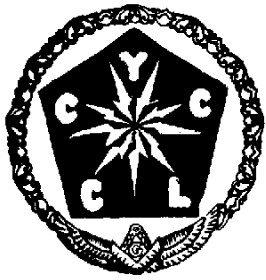
