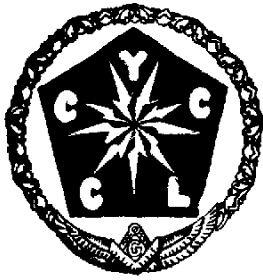
The proclamation was made by the Grand Marshal.
