The Eminent Prior announced the passing of Knight William Henry Cantwell, KYGCH, PP, on April 19, 1987. PP Law delivered a brief eulogy, following which a moment of silence was observed in Knight Cantwell's memory. It was announced that Knight Paul E. Wootten had been in ill health but appeared to be improving and was expected to return to his room in the Retirement Center. Eminent Prior Hurter then recounted his experiences with two cataract removal operations and that now all seemed to be satisfactory.


