The minutes of the previous meeting (Nov. 10, 1990) were read and approved as read. The Treasurer reported a balance of \$386.82.


A motion was made, seconded, and passed to meet Nov. 9, 1991, at 10:00 A.M. in the Masonic Temple, Wilmington, Delaware.
