

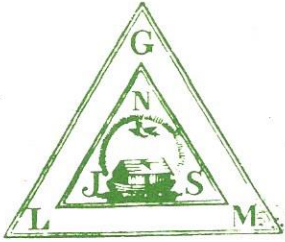
The Secretary reported that \$ 75 in donations had been received at the meeting.
