V.E.D. C. Granville McVey – York Rite Sovereign College – Grand Governor of Delaware

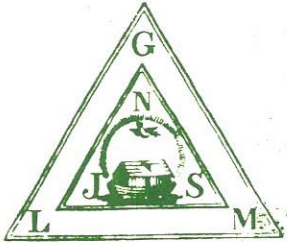
CN Atkinson thanked the installing officers for the installation and offered prayer for his term of office.
