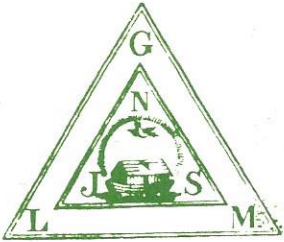
PCN Mark Irwin presented PCN Sheldon L. Edwards, Sr. with his Past Commander Noah's jewel.
